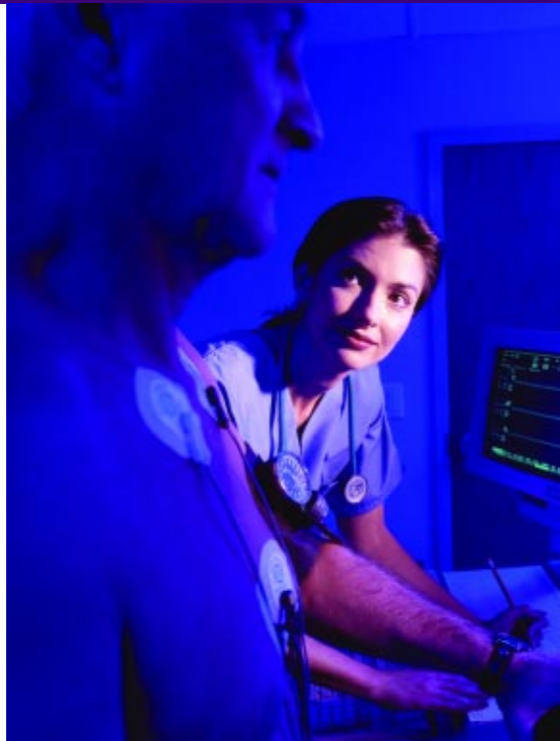


About Sancta Maria

Sancta Maria Hospital is a well equipped independent provider of high quality care which has served the community of Swansea and South West Wales for more than 50 years. Located in the Uplands area of Swansea, the hospital is set in its own grounds and overlooks the sweep of Swansea Bay.

Founded originally by the Sisters of the Ursulines of Jesus, since 1988 Sancta Maria has been owned by the Hospital Management Trust (HMT), a registered charity which has fostered the original ethos of care whilst being committed to providing accessible healthcare to all. The hospital is registered under the Care Standards Act and is inspected regularly. We also subscribe to external quality assurance programmes to demonstrate that the high standards we set and achieve are in line with current best practice.

Patients benefit from a highly skilled and competent team of staff who work alongside experienced consultants in surroundings designed to ensure comfort and ease of recovery. All patients rooms have a nurse call buzzer, telephone and television, and many are en-suite.



Patient Care

Using Sancta Maria's service means that you will be able to access the advice or treatment you need at a time convenient to you without undue delay.

We work with over 100 consultants, all of whom have recognised qualifications and experience in their respective fields. Your GP can help arrange an appointment, where your consultant will guide you through the process of planning your treatment.

Your consultant will then be personally responsible for your care throughout your time in hospital, supported by our team of highly trained, experienced nurses and healthcare professionals.

We recognise that good nutrition plays an important part of your recovery and our menus are planned with this in mind. A range of appetising options is available including special diets incorporating fresh, local produce wherever possible.

Services

Sancta Maria provides a range of surgical and medical treatments for all our clinical specialties. A list is given on the back of this brochure.

As a result of our charitable status, our charges are designed to enable patients to bridge the affordability gap between NHS care and expensive private hospitals.

Our services are available to patients who are covered by medical insurance, wish to fund their own treatment through our self-pay programme, or whose care here may have been agreed by the NHS.

Patients with medical insurance

The hospital is recognised by all the leading medical insurance companies with whom we have agreed special terms for the direct settlement of accounts.

Our patient accounts staff can assist you in clarifying the terms of your cover before your treatment begins and you should note that some insurers require authorisation before admission to hospital.

Patients funding their own care

For patients who are not insured, a self-pay quotation can be given prior to admission. This is an extremely popular option and the hospital is able to offer a wide range of treatments at set prices. A personal quotation can be provided at your request, and a medical loan facility is available to help budgeting for treatment costs. Please call us for more details.
